Blossoming Butterflies

This month the Baby Room will be looking at a range of baby animals. Interactive Experiences:

- Singing and reading books about baby animals
- Sensory tables set up with different textures and baby animal figurines
- Painting using animal prints and a variety of colours
- Art activity using the children's hands and feet to create animal pictures
- Alphabet animal flash cards to encourage recognition of words and letters
- Play dough using a variety of animal prints

Terrific Turtles

The Toddler Room will be learning about Spring

Interactive Experiences:

- Making a blossom tree using natural materials eg tree branches and different tissue paper
- Read books and research on iPads about the four seasons
- Making a flower collage using cut-outs from magazines about this spring topic
- Planting seedlings and Watching them grow
- Art activity using caterpillar, bees, beetles and flowers cut-outs
- Rainbow making using cotton wool and cut-out coloured paper
- Playdough using flower shapes
- Sensory using coloured rice, insects and real flowers

Keen Kittens

Through children interests the Kindy Room will be learning about Spring - Activities focused on the life cycle of plants and photosynthesis. Which allows children to gain information on how plants respond to various elements.

Interactive Experiences:

- Discuss interesting Spring facts with children using IPAD research
- Apple Science experience to create apple cinder eruption
- Sensory table of Archaeological dig
- Rain sticks used in small group activity to discuss the weather seasons
- Variety of literacy and numeracy experiences based on the season Spring
- Emotions rocks to identify and self regulate their emotions
- Setting up a Perfume Shop—making rainbow soap, different potions, etc
