Interactive Experiences:

- Reading books and singing songs that are related to this topic.

- Flash cards that identify the various countries
- Art and craft collage using a variety of community people cut – outs to encourage hand / eye coordination.
- Puppet play to promote recognition of the different cultures in our community.
- Obstacle course using soft play to promote gross motor skills

Terrific Turtles

The Toddler Room will be learning about space. This will be implement through children’s interests and conversations with educators to extend children’s learning.

Interactive Experiences:

- Making the Solar System Diorama
- Art and Craft making rockets using cut-out shapes
- Creating the Solar system using papermache planets.
- Making Telescopes using recycling materials
- Sensory experience using blue play dough with silver stars
- Sensory experience using black beans with glow in the dark planets
- Astronauts costumes promoting imaginary play
- Using iPads to watch educational videos on space /galaxy



Keen Kittens

It is important to introduce the concept of Community Helpers to help children recognise and trust the people who are responsible to serve and protect them. For example, Police officers, nurses, dentists, fireman, doctors, teachers etc.



Interactive Experiences:

- Sensory trays with sand and community village with people as props, eg police cars, police station, police people, community hospitals, doctors and nurses.
- STEM baking soda rocket experiment
- Small group times using numeracy and literacy matching cards
- Fire fighter numbered hand prints to promote numeracy
- Researching on iPads videos of Community Helpers eg doctors, paramedics and dentists
- French Baby Shark song with shark cut-outs incorporating pegs art activity
- Tracing the letter T in sand trays using their fingers
